In relation to unmarried cohabitants, we draw up cohabitation contracts and extended cohabitant wills.

For married couples as well as cohabiting couples, we can provide consultancy in relation to tax conditions.

Termination of community property constitutes a large part of our work in connection with divorces and separations. We advise about the conditions and circumstances of separation and divorce and draw up agreements on property division.

We also provide consultancy within Danish international family law. The growing globalisation has affected family law, as more and more marriages are ended across borders. Therefore, these cases are subject to foreign legislation. Thus, detailed knowledge of international conventions is of vital importance in several cases - in relation to the planning of the marriage as well as a possible ending of the marriage. Furthermore, knowledge of international rules and foreign legal matters also plays an important role in connection with consultancy of families planning to move away from Denmark for a short or a long period of time.
